The IVV, the International Volkssportverband, is an organisation that promotes popular sports activities worldwide. The IVV aims to make sporting activities accessible to people of all ages and abilities. The focus is on non-competitive activities such as walking, cycling, swimming and cross-country skiing.

Here are some key aspects of the IVV:

- ° The IVV organises and supports sporting events that focus on participation and the enjoyment of physical activity rather than competition or performance.
- ° The IVV is active in many countries and coordinates international events. It consists of national associations and clubs, which in turn organise local events.

One of the best-known activities is the so-called "IVV walks". These walks are often referred to as Volkssport-Walks and take place all over the world. Participants receive stamps and rewards for their participation, the so-called Volkssport badge.

By promoting regular sporting activities, IVV helps to improve the physical and mental health of participants.

IVV attaches great importance to the community and social aspect of sport. The aim is to bring people together so that they can be active together and make new friends.

IVV is a non-profit organisation and works closely with national and regional associations to ensure a wide range of events and activities.

Participation in IVV events is open to all, regardless of age, gender or fitness level.

IVV was founded in 1968 in Lindau, Germany, and was registered in 1972.

The founding countries were Germany, Austria, Switzerland and Liechtenstein.

The official languages are German and English.

The head office is in Altötting, Germany.

Awards are essential: they motivate people to continue their activities

Awards are powerful motivators for people taking part in Volkssport events as they provide a sense of achievement and recognition.

The prospect of a tangible awards or recognition for completing a strenuous hike, for example, can drive people to push their limits and overcome obstacles.

Awards create lasting memories and a sense of pride, which fosters a deeper connection to the activity and encourages participants to continue exploring the outdoors.

As an award and motivation: a special IVV prize!

As an award for participating in an IVV event anywhere in the world, there are evaluation stamps. Collecting these stamps in the IVV evaluation booklets entitles to rewards and honours!

If participation already entitles to ratings, i.e. "taking part is everything", one can also have a sporting performance recognised by the kilometres covered/completed.

After paying a small contribution towards expenses, one can receive a participation booklet and/or a kilometre evaluation booklet.









IVV Olympiads



The IVV Olympiad takes place every two years in an IVV member country. It is a multi-day popular sports festival that is open to all. The IVV Olympiad includes the disciplines of walking, swimming and cycling as well as other popular sports. The supporting programme offers participants numerous opportunities to make and maintain international friendships in a harmonious atmosphere.

The International Volkssportverband IVV is divided into three continental associations: IVV-Asia, IVV-Americas & Oceania and IVV-Europe. These continental associations were founded in 2011.

IVV-Europe has its headquarters in Luxembourg and operates under the legal form of an ASBL, a non-profit organisation.

Its members are mainly national Volkssport Federations.

At 1.1.2025, IVV-Europe will have National Federations and other members from 15 different European countries, representing more than 2,000 associations/clubs.

The current Presidium was elected in Sillien (A) in 2021.

The official languages of IVV-Europe are German, French and English.

The power of a reward: why recognition keeps you motivated

From the 7th Europiade in Waidring, the IVV Passport for the Europiade will be distributed free of charge. Each Europiade thus offers the opportunity to receive a special IVV classification stamp, which is awarded either for the kilometres covered or for participation.

Participants can receive stamps retroactively for all previous IVV Europiades if they can present corresponding proof such as IVV scorebooks or other proof of participation.

ach participant is entitled to one or more chargeable CERTIFICATES, which enhance both participation and the services provided. The number of participations is in the colours of the rainbow, so it is worth collecting them.

Independently of the certificates, it is also possible to purchase the EUROPIADE PIN.

IVV-EUROPE CUP'S make popular sport attractive

The indispensable motivation through awards

IVV-Europe invites to take part in its Cups and discover the many IVV events throughout Europe! Cups with short, achievable goals are a strong motivator for participation in IVV walks as they provide a sense of fulfilment and recognition. The prospect of a tangible reward or recognition can inspire people to push their limits and overcome obstacles. Cups create lasting memories and a sense of pride, foster a deeper connection to the IVV activity and encourage participants to explore IVV organisations further.

The FELIX-CUP is designed to encourage people to hike in their home country as well as in neighbouring countries. The cup is not only aimed at long-distance and extreme hikers, but at all hikers, regardless of the distance travelled and the type of event. 'FELIX' comes from the Latin word for "happy" and "bringing happiness", which emphasises the positive influence of hiking on well-being. The four-leaf clover, a symbol of happiness, represents the cup. The four leaves stand for the number of IVV hikes and the IVV member countries to be visited. The colours of the leaves, which correspond to those of the rainbow, symbolise peace, new beginnings, change, tolerance, acceptance, hope and longing.

Conditions of participation: Participation in 4 IVV organisations in 4 different European countries.

The Newsflash will be sent to all European IVV members with the request to forward it to all affiliated clubs. It will also be published on the IVV-Europe website.






